whole (**hole**) - entire, complete, having all its parts, all of one thing. (He ate the whole peach. I bought a whole car. This is a whole circle. ○)

group (**groop**) - more than one person or thing together. (The group of students sat together at lunch. This is a group of circles. ○ ○ ○ ○ ○)

part (**part**) - a portion of a whole or a group. (I ate a part of the pizza. Part of the whole circle is shaded. ◐ Part of the group is shaded. ●●○○○○).
